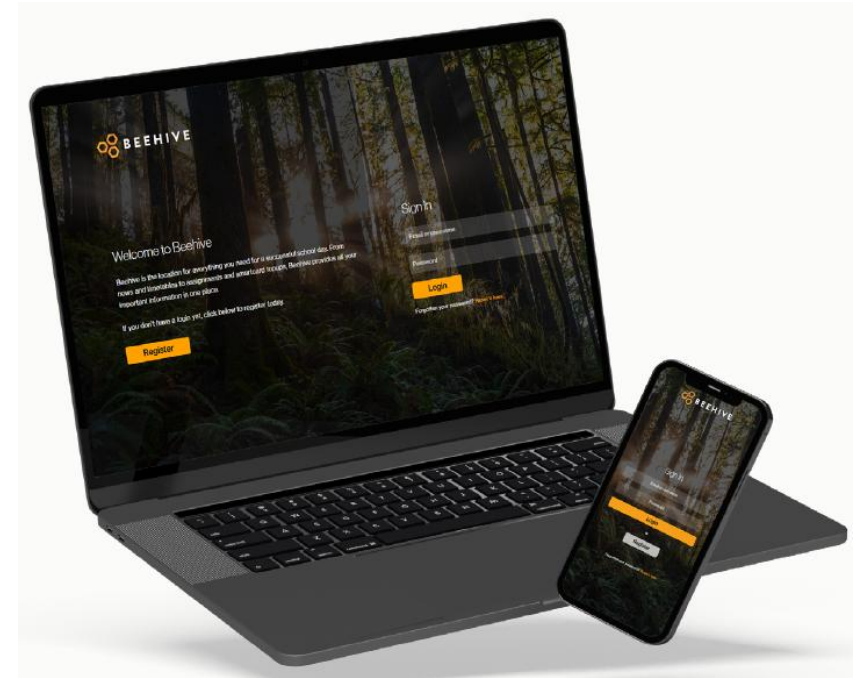

You can Filter your Assignments from ones that are Due, In Progress, Completed or Late

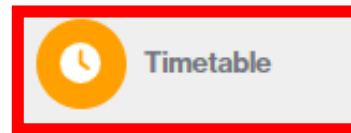
Each Assignment will show the title and the Teacher who set the Assignment

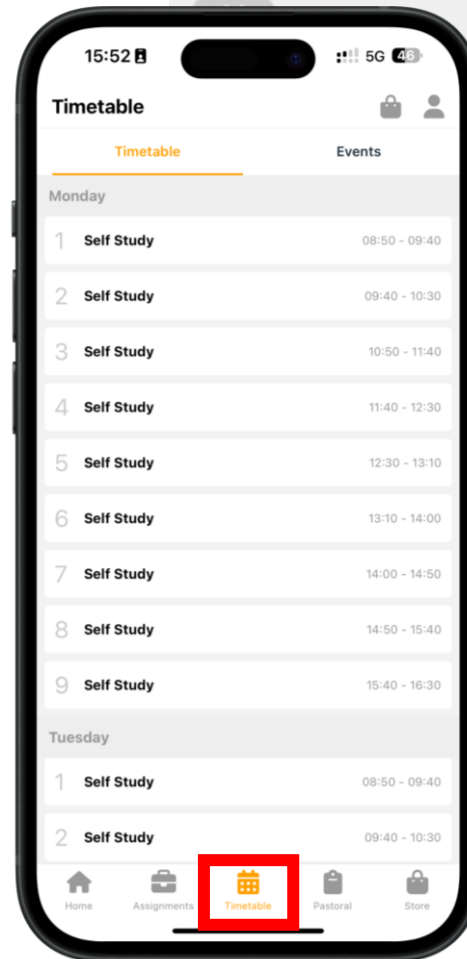
Checking Class Timetables

Topping Up your Smartcard

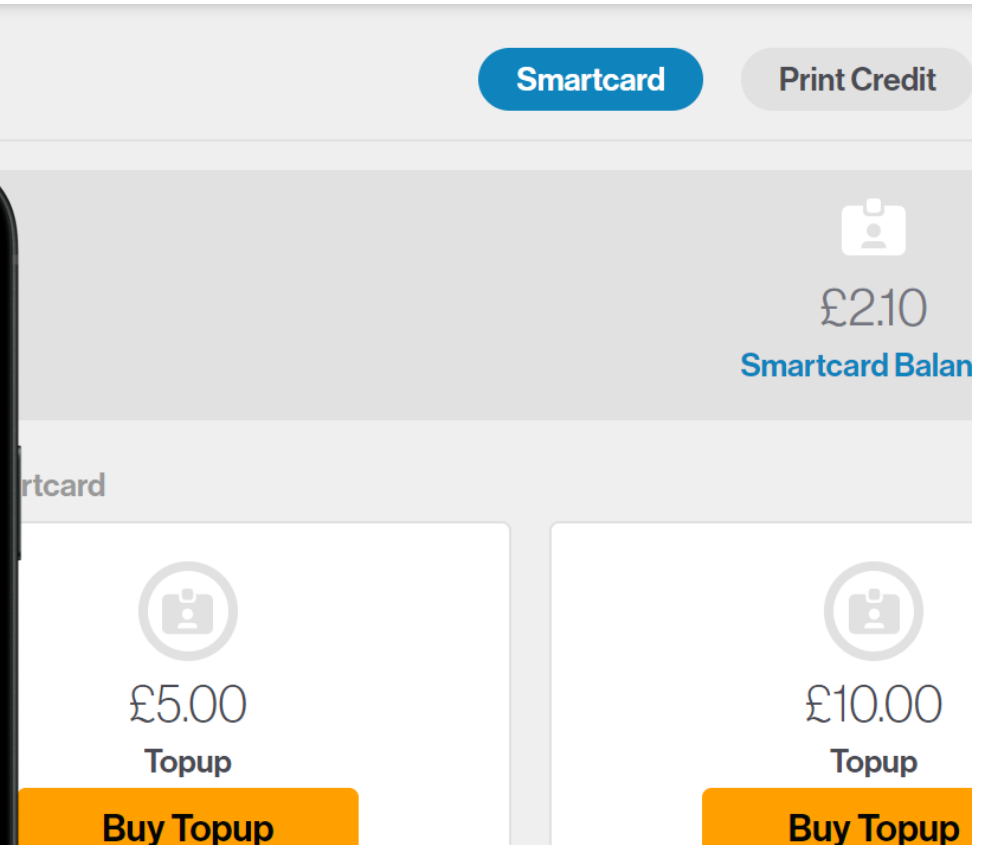
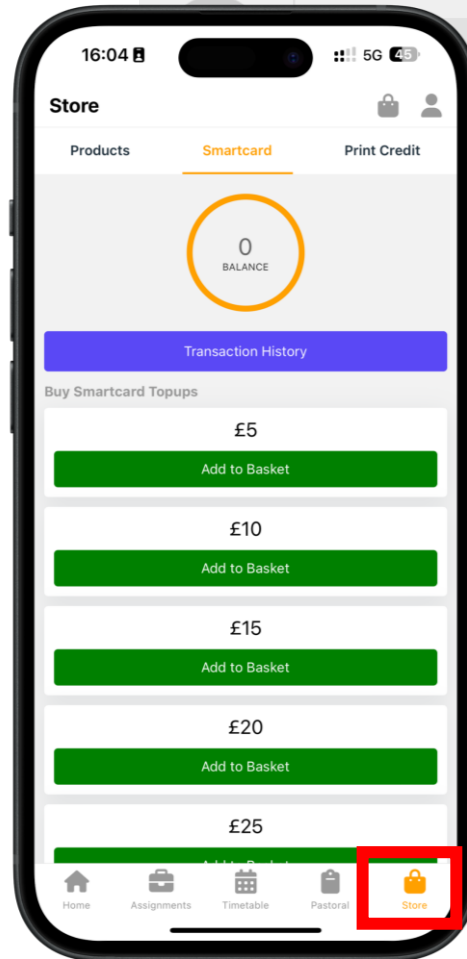


Your Smartcard is not only required to be always worn with you but it's also essential to purchase Food and print resources.

Tracking Rewards and Behaviour Points



In Classes, if you perform well, show great effort and follow the 4 R's, you will receive points that will earn you rewards such as Free Waffles!

Alternatively, there are also Behaviour points for not holding college values which can result in detentions.

All your points can be tracked within Beehive to reflect your education progress.
